1 Let's remind ourselves in silence that we are in God's presence...

(pause...)

- 2 The word "prophet" means "God's spokesman". It's **not** anything to do with trying to discover what's going to happen in the future.
- We read of the prophets (God's spokesmen) in the Old Testament. One of the prophets was called Micah. He spoke very simply about three qualities that are needed to live a good life:
- 4 "To act justly, to love tenderly, and to walk humbly with God

(Micah 68)

5 We make that our prayer today:

That we may act justly, love tenderly, and walk humbly with you, our God.

6 They are easy words to remember, and they are the kind of words that some people learn and repeat a few times during the day, reminding themselves that God is with them. This is an excerpt from the page of this date in 'Praying Each Day of the Year', a 3-volume book by Nicholas Hutchinson, FSC.
