- 1 Our nearest star, of course, is the Sun. Stars that are relatively close to each other are said to form a "galaxy".
- 2 There are about 1,000 million stars in our own galaxy which is often called "The Milky Way".
- 3 There are about 100,000 million galaxies throughout the whole of the Universe.
- 4 We can't begin to grasp these numbers, but the Earth is a small planet travelling around one sun amongst about 100 million million stars!
