- 1 This was the birthday in 1874 of Ernest Shackleton, who would become an explorer of the South Pole. In the London *'Times'* newspaper, Shackleton printed a small advertisement:
- 2 "Men wanted for hazardous journey. Small wages, bitter cold, long months of complete darkness, constant danger, safe return doubtful. Honour and recognition in case of success."
- 5,000 people replied to the advertisement, and Sir Ernest Shackleton selected27 to join him in his exploration of Antarctica, the South Pole.
- 4 Let's pause for a moment to think why it might have been that so many replied to that advertisement.

(pause...)

5 Let us pray:

God our Father, there are many difficulties and challenges in life, and we see or experience more of them each day we live. Give us the power of your Holy Spirit that we may have courage and determination. and may live in such a way that we encourage one another. Enable us to transform whatever is negative, and remain positive in attitude throughout our lives. Lighten our darkness and keep us safe. Amen.
