- 1 Whilst London's rapid transport system is called "the Underground" or "the Tube", the system in Paris is known as "the Metro".
- 2 Yesterday is the anniversary, in the year 1863, of the opening in London of the world's first underground railway system. London Underground is the world's longest over 250 miles (400 kms) in length.
- 3 Let us pray for all who will be making journeys today:

## We pray, Lord,

- for those who are going to a new job and for those who are going to work for the last time today;
- for the emergency services who will travel at high speed on land, water or in the air, to bring help to others;
- for those starting a new life as they move house;
- for those travelling to or from prison;
- for people who will go into hospital today;
- for young people on their way to school, college and university;
- for those who are lost on the journey of life;
- for those who will die today and make their final journey.

## On all these people

we ask your blessing, Lord. Amen.
