- 2 We pray for our families and friends that the power of the Holy Spirit may be in our lives, so that we may live fully with his gifts of wisdom and understanding, of knowledge and right judgement, of courage and reverence, and of wonder and awe in God's presence. Lord, in your mercy,
 - hear our prayer.
- 3 Let's pray for those about to sit exams, that nothing may prevent them from doing as well as they deserve. Lord, in your mercy, hear our prayer.
- 4 We pray for all in the mass media - in TV, radio, films, newspapers, advertising and the Internet. that they may be guided by good principles and the best motives. We pray for wisdom ourselves that, amidst the influences and pressures around us, we may make good decisions and grow in wisdom and character each day. Lord, in your mercy,

hear our prayer.
