- 1 The persecution of Christians has been severe in Communist countries. Karl Marx was the inspiration behind Communism.
- 2 The daughter of Karl Marx explained to a friend that she had never been brought up in any religion, and had never been religious in any way. She said that she had just come across a prayer *"which I really wish could be true"*, she said.
- 3 She was asked about the prayer. Then slowly, the daughter of the founder of Marxism began to say: "Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name..."
- 4 Let's remind ourselves for a moment that we are in our Father's presence...

(Pause...)

- 5 Let's pray those same words "the Lord's Prayer" - joining in spirit with those millions of people down the ages who have suffered and been imprisoned and tortured for their faith:
- 6 Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil.
